Cabrini Outreach has opened a new primary health clinic. All health care provided by the clinic is free.

### Who can attend?

The clinic is for people seeking asylum, undocumented migrants (no visa), vulnerable temporary visa holders and refugees up to six months after arrival.

**Priority will be for people who don't have Medicare.**

*The nurse can assess your health and provide some treatment. The doctor can diagnose your health issues, give you medicine, and refer to specialists.*

### Is it safe to go?

The clinic is safe for everyone. It is safe even if you don't have a visa. Interpreters are available over the phone or in person, and the staff will understand your situation.

The clinic is COVID-safe. You will have your temperature checked on arrival and you will be given a mask if you don't have one.
